Weald & Downland Living Museum

Along the route, you'll pass the Weald & Downland Museum, a remarkable open-air museum showcasing rescued rural homes and buildings nestled in a stunning landscape. The collection spans over 1,000 years of history, telling the stories of everyday life in Southeast England through immersive exhibits and architecture.

Explore Arundel

Independent shops, galleries, and cafés from the historic centre down to the River Arun.

Arundel Castle

Arundel Castle is a beautifully medieval fortress. Though damaged during the English Civil War, it remains a powerful symbol of resilience and heritage. Located just three miles from the hotel.

Portsmouth Historic Dockyard Step aboard history at Portsmouth Historic Dockyard, home to some of the world's most iconic naval vessels. Discover HMS Victory, Admiral Nelson's flagship at the Battle of Trafalgar, and HMS Warrior 1860, Britain's first iron-hulled warship. Explore the National Museum of the Royal Navy Portsmouth, where the story of the Royal Navy unfolds—past, present, and future—all in one extraordinary location.



Portsmouth Historic Dockyard

The Mary Rose Museum The secrets of Tudor England at the Mary Rose Museum, where the remains of King Henry VIII's beloved warship are preserved alongside thousands of artefacts recovered from the Solent seabed. Built between 1509 and 1511, the Mary Rose was a pioneering vessel—one of the first capable of firing a broadside. After decades of loyal service, she tragically sank during battle in 1545. Her rediscovery and dramatic raising in 1982 marked a turning point in maritime archaeology.



Mary Rose Museum,

Following a 34-year conservation project, the Mary Rose is now magnificently displayed in a purpose-built museum, offering an immersive glimpse into life aboard a Tudor warship.

Gunwharf Quays is home to over 90 famous brands all up to 60% off the regular retail price.

Private Dinner in the Amberley Castle,
Great Hall.

Amberley Castle is a luxury hotel in the picturesque village of Amberley at the foot of the South Downs, a 900-year-old castle wall and portcullis that remains open.

Marked by two large turrets this picturesque 900-year-old English castle was once owned by Queen Elizabeth I.

Fishbourne Roman Palace

Petworth House
